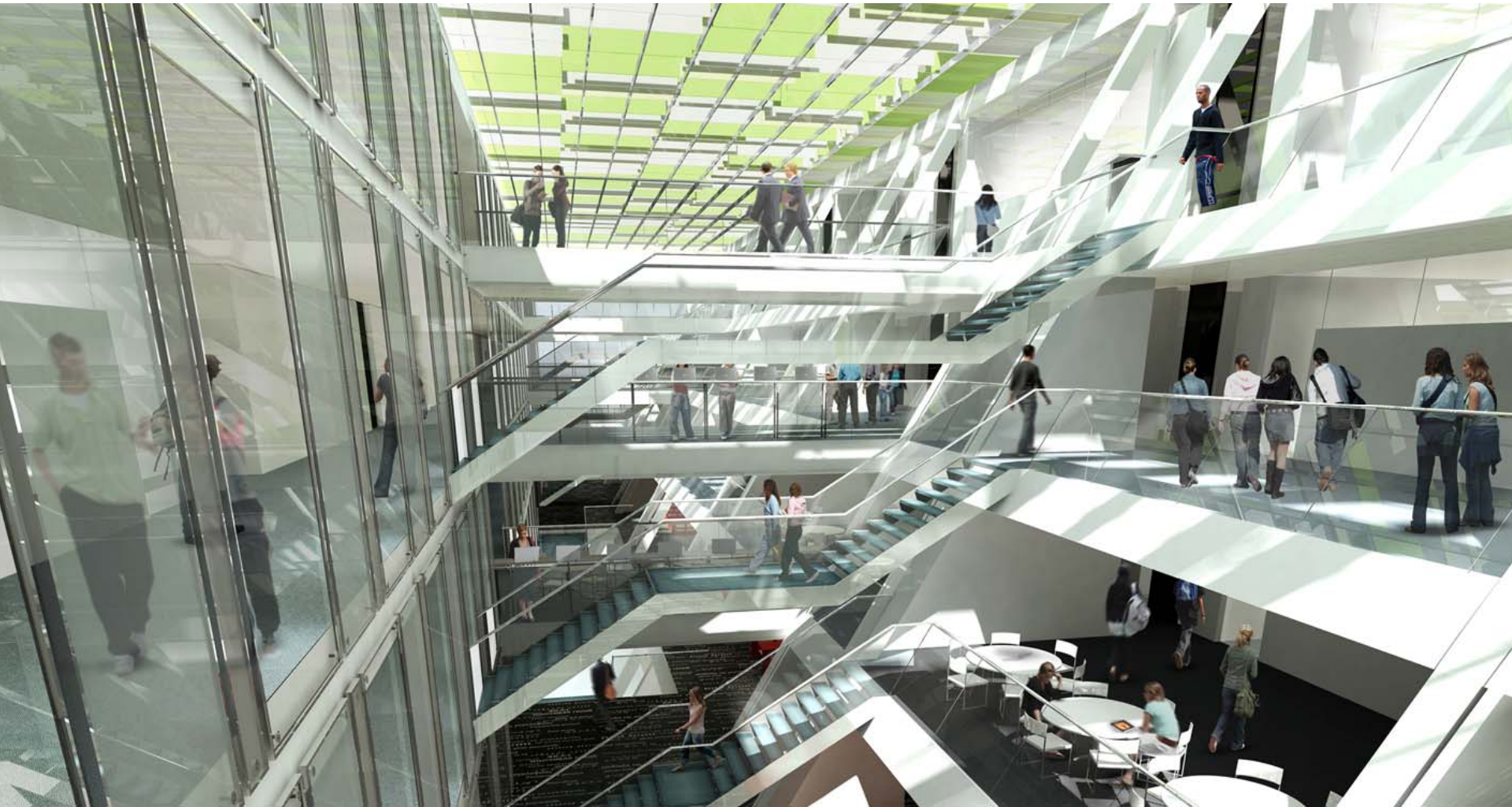

OUTSTANDING RESULTS

Once again they are, by many measures, the best our students have every achieved

The school's early entry scheme has proved to be a great success. Every single student in our new Year 11 enters their final GCSE year with at least 5 GCSE level qualifications 'banked'. 73% have the vital GCSE English qualification and 68% have Maths. The next point of entry for these two GCSEs is November.

Wear your uniform as supplied and not alter it in any way.

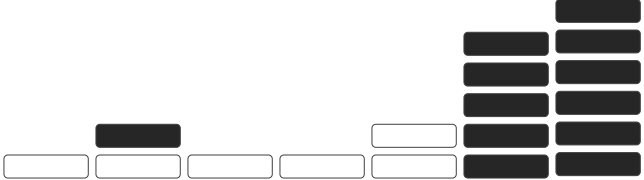
Wear your blouse lapel outside your jacket.

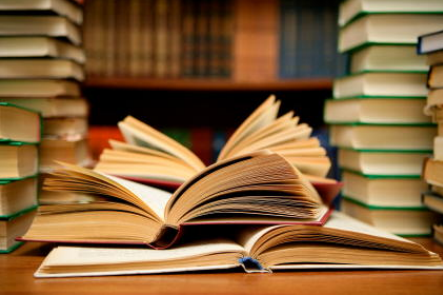

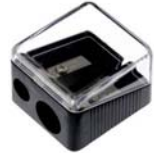
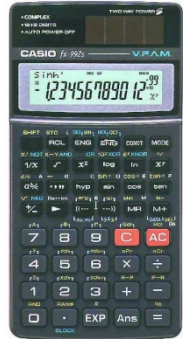
