



## The Holland Park School Pupil Charter

Beginning in 2025-26 and being rolled out over three years, Holland Park School's Pupil Charter, will guarantee that all students joining in Year 7 will have the opportunity to experience a defined set of activities and opportunities throughout their time at the school from Year 7 to Year 13.

At the end of each term, a Pupil Charter Report will be shared with parents, providing updates on the activities their children have participated in. The range of experiences recorded in these reports is expected to grow as students progress through the school.

### Each year all students will:

- Take part in at least one extra-curricular club, within or outside of school, attending for the duration of the club (or for a minimum of one term across several clubs).
- Represent their house / tutor group / class in individual and team activities.
- Share their views on the school through student leadership structures and student voice
- Reflect on their aspirations and personal development goals with an adult in the school.
- Hear from an inspirational speaker

### In Key Stage 3, all students will:

- Have the opportunity to represent the school in a sporting, cultural or academic event.
- Have the opportunity to perform in a class production to an audience
- Watch a theatre production.
- Volunteer time to serve the local community.
- Have the opportunity to stay away from home and bond with classmates on a residential trip.
- Have the opportunity to demonstrate leadership.
- Deliver a presentation to an audience.
- Celebrate people, cultures and cuisines from foreign countries.
- Visit a Russell Group university.

### In Key Stage 4, all students will:

- Watch a live professional performance, production, sporting or cultural event
- Volunteer time to serve the local community.
- Demonstrate leadership to the wider school.
- Apply for or elect students to senior leadership positions.
- Deliver a presentation to an audience.
- Experience a professional workplace.
- Visit a different Russell Group university.
